

## Terms and Conditions:



1. Parent, guardian must take an active participatory role in supervision of all children at the party.
2. Duty of care remains the responsibility of the birthday host.
3. Appropriate clothing to be worn – e.g. shorts, t-shirts, buckles, zips, shoes, socks or jeans to be worn. (socks may be worn if your child has verruca's)
4. No Jewellery / watches are to be worn.
5. No food or drink allowed in the gymnasium. Food and drink to be consumed in the party room at the tables.
6. Advise all parents to please pick up their children up to 5-10 minutes before the end of the party (to allow for those last goodbyes and thank you's) – as the gymnasium needs to be cleared, tidied and prepared for the next party.
7. Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated by the Coach and we do hold the right to ask a child to sit out, if this behaviour is dangerous to themselves or others.
8. As soon as a date and time has been confirmed a deposit of £50 is required, with the balance payable on the day or before. Once the time and date are agreed the deposit is non-refundable.
9. We may provide money-off party vouchers to the children attending the party. These vouchers can be used by members and non-members alike.
10. We may provide vouchers for free gymnastics sessions. These vouchers are intended to attract new members to the club and may not be used by existing members. They may not be used in addition to any other offer of a free session. They can be given to a friend.
11. Hirer is liable for any damage caused to our property or equipment.
12. J Star Gymnastics is not responsible for any items lost or stolen. Please leave valuables at home.

Please respect the property of J Star Gymnastics.

\*Members are defined as children who have been attending J Star Gymnastics for at least 1 month at the time of booking.

### Cancellation Policy:

If you cancel more than 14 days of the agreed party date 80% of the deposit will be refundable.

If you cancel less than 14 days of the agreed party date, no refund will be given.

### Party Policies

- ❖ Any child going on the equipment in the gym is considered a party participant and must be listed as such and paid for as such.
- ❖ Adults wishing to take photographs/ video are welcome to but please check with the Birthday child's parents to confirm all party participants have agreed to this. Some parents do not want their children in photos that may be used for social media so please respect their wishes.
- ❖ Children three years old and younger must be accompanied by a parent.
- ❖ Parties should be booked at least one week prior to the party. You can phone us to try for last minute availability and we will accommodate as best we can (dependant on hall hire, coach availability etc...)
- ❖ Please avoid zippers and buttons – they can hurt with various skills.  
No dresses or skirts – no showing off in the gym please!!  
Long hair tied back in a pony tail – hair can get caught in the equipment if not properly secured back.  
No runners, shoes or socks on the gymnastics floors – bare feet only!!
- ❖ All party participants must follow the coaches instructions at all times.  
If a child does not wish to stay with the party, they must stay in the party room with a supervising adult until the party is finished on the floor.
- ❖ Mums and dads, please remember that the party is for children only. Adults are there to supervise and not participate! You are not insured.

**No party participants are permitted on the gymnastics floor, on equipment or in the foam pits without the permission of the coach & with the supervision of the coach.**

All attendees are insured with liability insurance only, not accident insurance, for a one-time visit by Gymnastics BC. It is the responsibility of the host parent to inform all parents of the children who are attending
